Sunday summary - Jesus' mission was to seek and save the lost. To accomplish this Jesus often ate and drank with "sinners".

Intro question: Growing up, was your family culture one that invited others into your home?

Read Luke 19:1-10

What was remarkable about Jesus eating with tax collectors?
What occupations in today's society would be considered the lowest on the moral ladder scale?
How would you feel about eating with these people?
How would Jesus feel about eating with these people?

Who did Jesus eat with in these stories?

Luke 7:36-50
Luke 10:38-42
Luke 19:1-10
John 21:12-13

If Jesus was in your school or work place cafeteria everyday, who do you think he would have lunch with?

Applications: Commit to find a new person who you do not normally eat with to have lunch, supper, or a coffee with this week.

For boldness to reach out to others not like us or unknown to us.
For Jesus heart and eyes for the 'lost' in our neighborhood, work place, school, and city.
