*Sunday summary - We come a long legacy of people putting their faith into action, of people using what God has put in their hands to reveal His heart and purpose in this world.*

Intro question - Do you have any heroes of the faith? Share with group who your hero is and what great things they have done for God.

Read James 2:14-26

Discuss how important deeds, like the good works spoken of in this passage, are to showing your faith.

Read Acts 17:26-27

Do you believe that where you are living now, has a strategic kingdom purpose?

God sets the lonely in families;  
he leads out the prisoners with singing . . . (Ps 68:5-6)

In the parable of the feeding of five thousand in Mark 6:32-44 - Jesus instructs the disciples to go and see how many loaves the crowd had before he multiplied it.

What is in your hand that God may want to multiply to meet the needs of others?

Quiet prayer: Reflect and wait on God to where He may be wanting you to put your faith into action and reach out.
